ABOUT HOLY SPIRIT SEMINARY

Holy Spirit Seminary is the place where future priests are prepared, trained and formed for ordained ministry for the five dioceses of Queensland: Brisbane, Rockhampton, Toowoomba, Townsville and Cairns.

Founded by the Queensland bishops in 1941 as Pius XII Seminary, the seminary now shares the original site with the Brisbane campus of Australian Catholic University (ACU), where the seminarians undertake some of their theology, philosophy, history, scripture and liturgy studies.

Seminarians live in one of six residential houses onsite in groups of between three and eight which prepares them for community living as future priests. Seminarians do their own cooking, cleaning, and household chores.

The daily schedule begins each day with Morning Prayer, silent meditation and then Mass. Seminarians plan the liturgies and participate in various liturgical ministries, including music, reader and altar server.

The seminary feast day is Pentecost which we celebrate this Sunday. The annual seminary magazine 'The Paraclete' is due to be released across Queensland this week. Our Diocese of Rockhampton has two seminarians, Grant (Pastoral Year) and Shane (second year); we need more. Perhaps you know someone? Perhaps you are that someone?
