Did you know... :

About the Scrutinies?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) includes three special rituals known as the scrutinies. On the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent, the Elect (those preparing for baptism) participate in these 'Scrutinies' which are rituals during Sunday Mass in which we ask God's protection for them against sin and temptation, and strength to live the Christian life.

Each of the scrutinies draws on the spiritual meaning of the gospel passage for the Mass of that Sunday. At the first Scrutiny, the Elect are likened to the woman of Samaria who thirsted for living water. At the second Scrutiny, we pray that God will free them from the blindness caused by false values, just as the man born blind was made to see. And in the third Scrutiny we pray they will be free from the grasp of death and brought to life in the sacraments, just as Lazarus was raised to life by Christ.

This year, Danika Pedruzzi is preparing for baptism at the Easter Vigil and will celebrate the First Scrutiny this Sunday morning. Please pray for her as she journeys towards the new life of baptism this Easter.

Second Sunday of Lent





Priscilla lives in the Hwange district in Zimbabwe with her husband, Charles, and their two grandsons. Climate change continues to bring unprecedented challenges for people living in the most vulnerable and remote communities in Zimbabwe.

With the support of Caritas Hwange, Priscilla learnt conservation

farming skills to grow drought-resistant crops to support her family during the current food crisis. Priscilla was able to produce a bumper harvest in her first year of practising conservation farming. Priscilla used the funds from her harvest to start poultry farming, which enabled her to sell eggs to pay for her grandchildren's school fees, books and stationery. The poultry farming provides a safety net for Priscilla and her family during times of hardship, like the current drought.

While the situation in Zimbabwe and across eastern Africa remains dire, the work of Caritas Hwange means that Priscilla can learn the skills she needs to build resilience and support her family during this current food crisis.
