ABOUT THE CHRISM MASS?

Last Thursday, Bishop Michael celebrated the Chrism Mass in Rockhampton Cathedral, joined by priests from across the diocese and many of the faithful.

The word *Christ* means "Anointed One," and anointing with oil is central to many of the most sacred moments in our Catholic life - Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Orders, and Anointing of the Sick. The oils used in these sacraments are blessed and consecrated each year at the Chrism Mass.

While the Chrism Mass is customarily celebrated on the morning of Thursday of Holy Week, the Roman Missal permits it to be celebrated on another date closer to Easter if it is difficult for the clergy to gather with the Bishop then. This is the case in many Dioceses in Australia, including our own where due to vast geographic distances required to be travelled by many priests, another date is more sensible. At the Mass, the Bishop blesses the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens, and consecrates the Chrism oil - a fragrant mixture of oil and balsam used in Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders. These sacred oils are then distributed to representatives of each parish for use throughout the coming year.

The Chrism Mass is also a special moment for our priests. Each year, they renew the promises made at their ordination.

One of the popular devotions of our Church is the Divine Mercy Novena, a period of nine days of prayer leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Novena starts on Good Friday and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday - 27 April. There is a special intention allocated for each of the nine days of prayer:

- 1st day | All Mankind especially all sinners
 2nd day | All Priests and Religious
 3rd day | All Devout and Faithful Souls
 4th day | All those who do not believe in God
 5th day | The souls who have separated themselves from the Church
- 6th day | The meek and humble souls of little children7th day | The souls who particularly venerate and glorify Jesus' mercy

8th day | The souls who are detained in purgatory 9th day | The souls who have become lukewarm

EASTER TRIDUUM

The Easter Triduum begins this Thursday with the Mass of the Lord's Supper | 6:30pm at which we recall the institution of the Eucharist and the Lord's command to be servants to one another. It concludes with a vigil of prayer in front of the Blessed Sacrament at the altar of repose. The next day, Good Friday, we commemorate the Lord's Passion | 3:00pm in a solemn liturgy including

the veneration of the cross. On the evening of Holy Saturday, the Easter Vigil | 6:30pm is the high point of the church's liturgical year. The liturgy begins with the service of light outside the church, then moves inside to hear the extended vigil of readings telling the story of salvation. This is followed by the celebration of baptism and confirmation for the seven adults who have been



journeying through the RCIA process. Please be aware that this Mass will go for longer than a normal Sunday Mass as it is the climax of the long season of penitence of Lent.
