About the Catechism of the Catholic Church?

A catechism is a summary of the teaching of the Catholic Church.

Everything that the Church believes is drawn from what God has revealed in the Bible and handed on from the Apostles in the Tradition of the Church. The Bible is the “primary source” document and it alone contains the divinely inspired words that God has spoken to us through specially chosen human writers. It is in the Bible and the living Tradition of the Church that God's Revelation comes to us.

The catechism on the other hand, is a document written by human beings and not directly inspired by God, so it is not a replacement for the Bible.

But the catechism is a very helpful and useful tool for us to see the teachings of our faith in a systematic and ordered way. It is the result of hundreds of years of saints, theologians and ordinary Catholics reflecting on and thinking about the deeds and words of God, and reasoning through what that all means for our doctrines about God and humanity, and about how we should live our lives.

You can easily find the Catechism of the Catholic Church online, or it is available in hard copy through any Catholic bookstore. I would recommend it as a very helpful addition to the bookshelf of every Catholic family.


