ABOUT THE SANTO NIÑO DE CEBU?



On the third Sunday in January, the Filipino community (especially Filipinos from Cebu) celebrate an important feast of their cultural history. The Santo Niño de Cebu (the holy child of Cebu) is a revered wooden statue of the Christ child. It is the oldest Christian artefact in the Philippines, given by the Spanish conqueror Ferdinand Magellan to the rulers of Cebu, Queen Juana and Rajah Jumabon, during the first Christian baptism in the country.

This statue depicts the infant Jesus as a Spanish king with crown, sceptre and orb. This statue has become a powerful symbol of faith in the Filipino community, and carries profound spiritual, cultural and emotional meaning. It represents childlike love and hope, and the central role of the Christian faith among the Filipino people. This feast will be marked at the 8am Mass this Sunday, with a procession of the statue and a traditional Filipino dance.

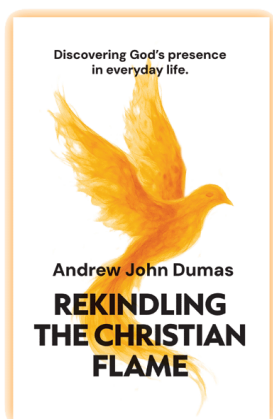
