Did you know...

About the General Intercessions?

At the end of the Liturgy of the Word during Mass, straight after we say the Creed, we pray the *General Intercessions* (or the *Prayer of the Faithful*). These are a series of briefly worded intentions that the reader invites the people (i.e. the 'Faithful') to pray for.

These prayers are generally offered for the needs of the church, for public authorities, the salvation of the world, for those burdened by difficulties and for local needs. Importantly, it is not the reader who is doing the praying here; he or she is simply announcing the intentions and

inviting the congregation to pray for those intentions. This is why we have a significant pause before the reader announces, "Lord, hear us", or "We pray to the Lord". This pause should be long enough for the people to pray in silence for the intention just announced.

In this way, the believers exercise "the office of their baptismal priesthood, offering prayers to God for the salvation of all." (General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 69)


