Did you know...

About the Baptismal Font?

The baptismal font in a parish church is one of the more important sacred furnishings. This is the place where new members are welcomed into the church and given the gift of new life in Christ.

The location of the baptismal font can vary depending on the architecture of the church, but a common practice is to locate it in a dedicated place close to the entrance to the church. The symbolism is clear: it is through the waters of baptism that one enters the mystical body of Christ which is the Church.

Traditionally, baptismal fonts have often been octagonal in shape (although this is not mandatory). This is an ancient symbolism that sees the day of Resurrection as the *eighth* day; that is, the Sunday of the Resurrection represents a new beginning, a new creation. If the first day of the week represents the beginning of God's creation of the universe, the Sunday of the Resurrection – the "eighth day" - represents the beginning of the *new* creation. Hence, the eight sides of the baptismal font.


