

Did you know?

ABOUT THE ADVENT WREATH?

Today we begin the Season of Advent, which also marks the beginning of our liturgical year. One of the more recognisable symbols of this season is the Advent wreath, containing four candles for each of the Sundays of Advent.

The wreath with its candles heightens our sense of expectation as the days draw nearer to the celebration of Christ's coming among us at Christmas. This tradition was first used by Lutheran Christians in the sixteenth century, but gradually spread to other Christian communities as well.

The Advent wreath with its four candles is a perfect tradition to practise at home, especially with younger children. There are many simple Advent prayer rituals for use in the home, which can be found online.



Scan the QR code for one option you might like to use. You might also like to take some holy water from the Church to sprinkle on your Advent wreath and candles, and then light each of the candles as we make our way through the four Sundays of Advent.


